## Policy Acknowledgment

The Tucson Nihongo Café is a program created and run by The Tucson Japanese Language School. Participation in the program is on a first-come first-serve basis, and at the discretion of the school executives. The executives reserve the right to refuse participation to anyone. Noncompliance with the below listed policies will result in disqualification from participating in the program.

## Policies:

- Participants must register for the program in advance, and provide the information requested in the registration form along with a copy of a valid photo identification.
- Appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
- Appropriate language must be spoken at all times, whether in Japanese or English; foul language or inappropriate subjects of conversation will result in rejection from the program.
- The program eost is $\$ 5$ per session, to be paid upon arrival No refunds will be offered for partial sessions or if the participant is asked to leave due to violation of the policies.
- Japanese language must be spoken at all times to the best of the participants' abilities. While some English clarification or explanation may be used as needed, Japanese conversation should predominate.
- No alcoholic beverages or smoking are permitted on school grounds. Participants who are suspected to be under the influence of any alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave, and refused participation from any further sessions.
